3. Eligibility

Participants should have completed or currently be enrolled in at least two courses at the King Sejong Institute, including cultural classes.

Individuals whose parents are native speakers of Korean are not eligible to participate.

4. Length Requirements

Speech: 2–5 minutes

Writing: 400–1,200 characters (scanned handwritten manuscript required)
