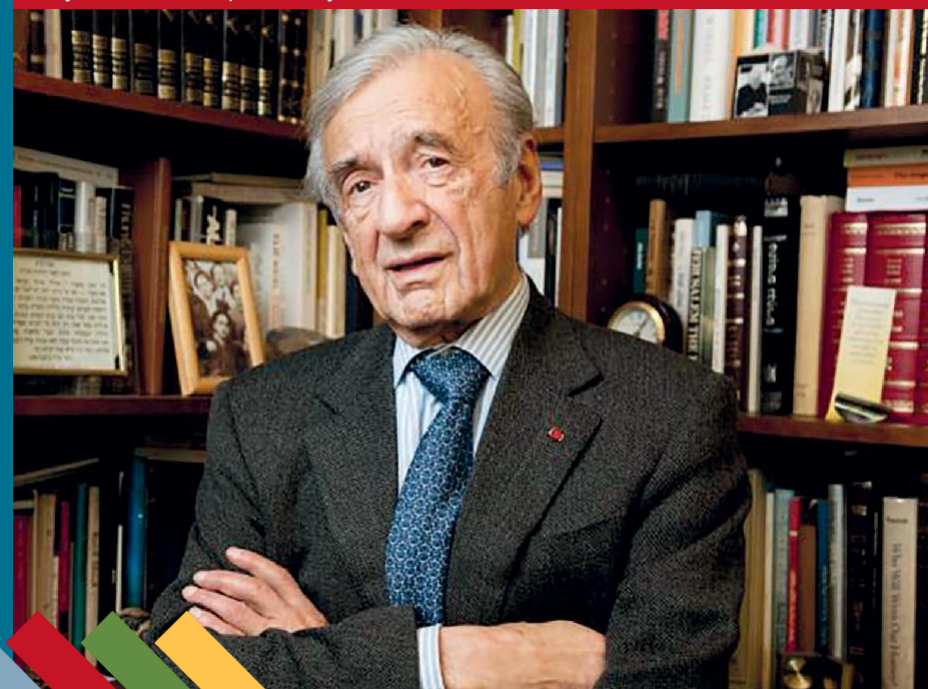

Who was Elie Wiesel?

Elie Wiesel (born in
Sighet, Romania, in
1928, died in New York,
USA, in 2016) was a
writer, university
professor, and
human rights activist. As
a survivor of the
Holocaust, he recorded his memories of his
time in Auschwitz and wrote biographies, novels,
writings on Judaism, and essays on
humanitarian and ethical issues, human dignity,
peace, and against hatred. His fundamental
concern was how the memory of inhumanity
can give rise to a message of human dignity
and peaceful coexistence between nations,
cultures, and religions.



In 1986, *Elie Wiesel* received the *Nobel Peace
Prize* for his commitment to the fight against
violence, racism, and oppression.

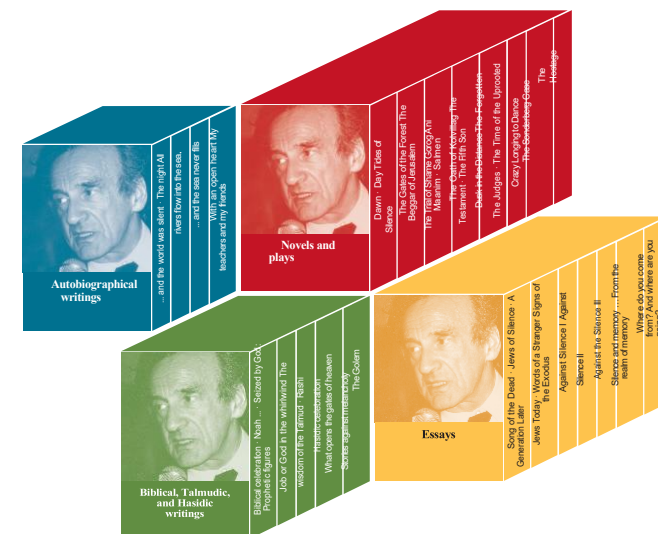
