Since 1989 Dr. Rainer Radtke from the Baden-Württembergische Brasilien-Zentrum of the University of Tübingen conducts four week zoological field trips to Brazil. In 2011 it will be his 16th field class taking this time 24 students and scientists from the state of Baden-Württemberg, especially from Tübingen university to different ecosystems in Brazil. This excursion is included in the German – Brazilian Year of Science, Technology and Innovation 2010/11.

The students will get introduced to Brazilian ecosystems like the Atlantic Rainforest, the Restinga vegetation, Cerrado, Pantanal and southern extensions of the Amazonian Rainforest. Fauna and flora will be observed especially in national parks and UNESCO biosphere reserves. Biodiversity and activities to protect endangered species like the Golden Lion Tamarin and the blue macaws are demonstrated in the wild. Local university students from partner or other universities contribute as invited speakers about ongoing projects.

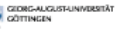
