Founded in 1960, **Universidade Federal Fluminense (UFF)** is a public institution, part of the Brazilian federal higher education system. Its headquarters are located in the city of Niterói and 9 other cities within the state of Rio de Janeiro. UFF's stated mission is to produce, disseminate, and apply knowledge and culture in a critical and socially relevant way.

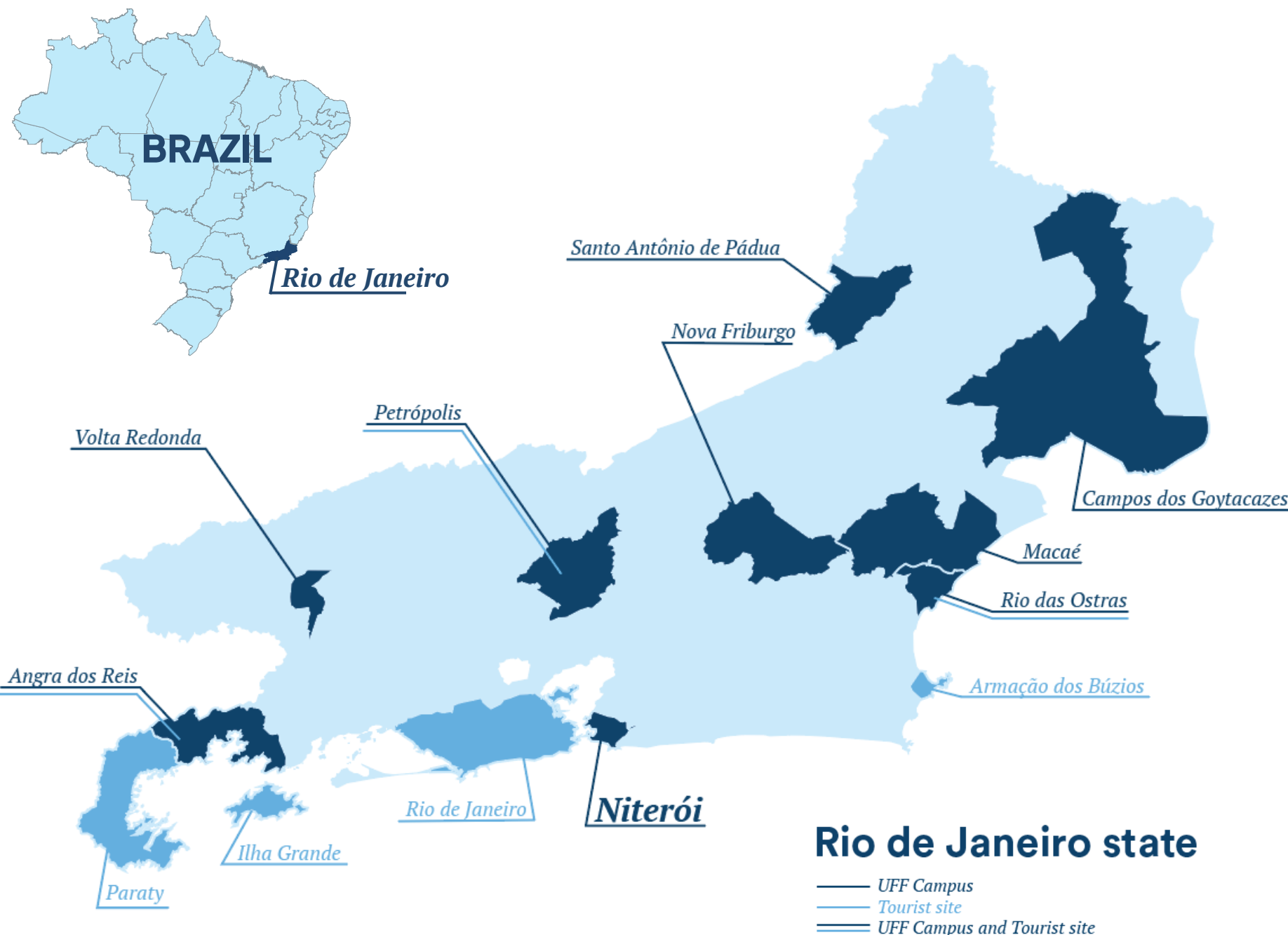
Niterói is only 13km away from the city of Rio de Janeiro, capital of the state, both located by the Guanabara Bay at the coast of the Atlantic Ocean. The city is a reference in services and quality of life, occupying the 7th position in the country's HDI index, and the 1st one in the state of Rio de Janeiro, showing that it is possible to grow in an organized way, generating jobs, income, and investments.

Niterói is an important economic hub, especially in the oil industry, including offshore companies and shipyards. It is also the city with the second largest number of Oscar Niemeyer's works.

Graduate students may apply for mobility throughout the year, on a continuous basis, having the International Cooperation Office website as a starting point. Students may come to UFF to undertake courses, to participate in research groups or to work in laboratories.

The program *International Labs* aims to encourage the active laboratories at the university whose *lingua franca* is English, to host more international graduate students, post-docs and researchers.

The Minor in Global Challenges brings together students and professors from around the world to debate the UN Sustainable Development Goals, with an emphasis on Inequalities.

It is an interdisciplinary program that complements the student's major, and it is offered entirely in a foreign language (English, Spanish, and French). They cover social and economic development issues in multiple areas of critical importance to humanity and the planet, seeking to realize equality and human rights. The student who completes the program receives a certificate of his studies.

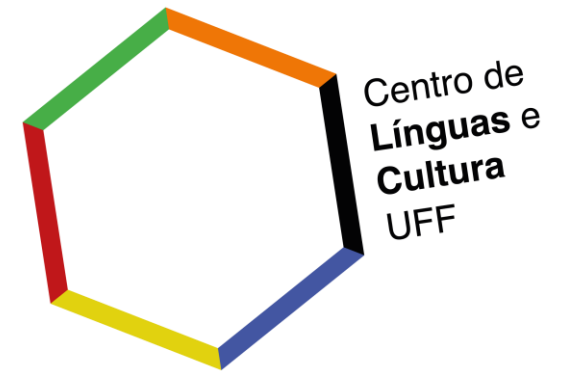

As the International Cooperation Office is well aware, the language barrier poses an issue to all forms of international relations. Bearing that in mind, and with the intention of opening our institution even further to the world, the *Center for Languages and Culture* launched initiatives for strengthen our multilingual activities for incoming mobility students, with the following activities:



Portuguese for Foreigners

International students can learn Portuguese through 3 different ways:

- Crash Course (30 hours, from two weeks to one month, on-site);
- Regular Course (60 hours, for a full semester on-site).

Our learning program, where UFF and international students learn Portuguese and other languages by practicing in a conversational matter.

Confucius Classroom

UFF is the proud host of a Confucius Classroom made in partnership with the Hebei Normal University and the Confucius Institute, in China. Students and people from Niterói can learn Chinese language and culture with native teachers.

Local Language Policy Initiatives – PULE

The Center for Languages and Culture also promotes local initiatives concerning language policy for a more inclusive process of academic internationalization. The *Programa de Universalização em Línguas Estrangeiras* (PULE) is a completely free three-year program of language teaching for students from socioeconomic vulnerability backgrounds in six different languages.

Writing Center

The Writing Center (CITE) assists UFF professors and students in the process of publishing scientific articles and other academic texts through proofreading, translation, and text advising.

UFF is the main cultural spot in Niterói, with an Arts Center that hosts international festivals and has always been praised by its high-quality equipment and spaces. The university also offers a wide range of facilities and initiatives, including:

- Shuttle buses between campuses;
- An innovation agency (Agir);
- University Farm;
- University Pharmacy;
- An Inclusion and Accessibility Office (Sensibiliza); and
- International studies centers.

At UFF, students are also encouraged to take part in extracurricular activities such as LGBTQI+ groups, religious meetings, women and race equality groups, athletics (sports associations), students' associations, outreach projects and other initiatives.

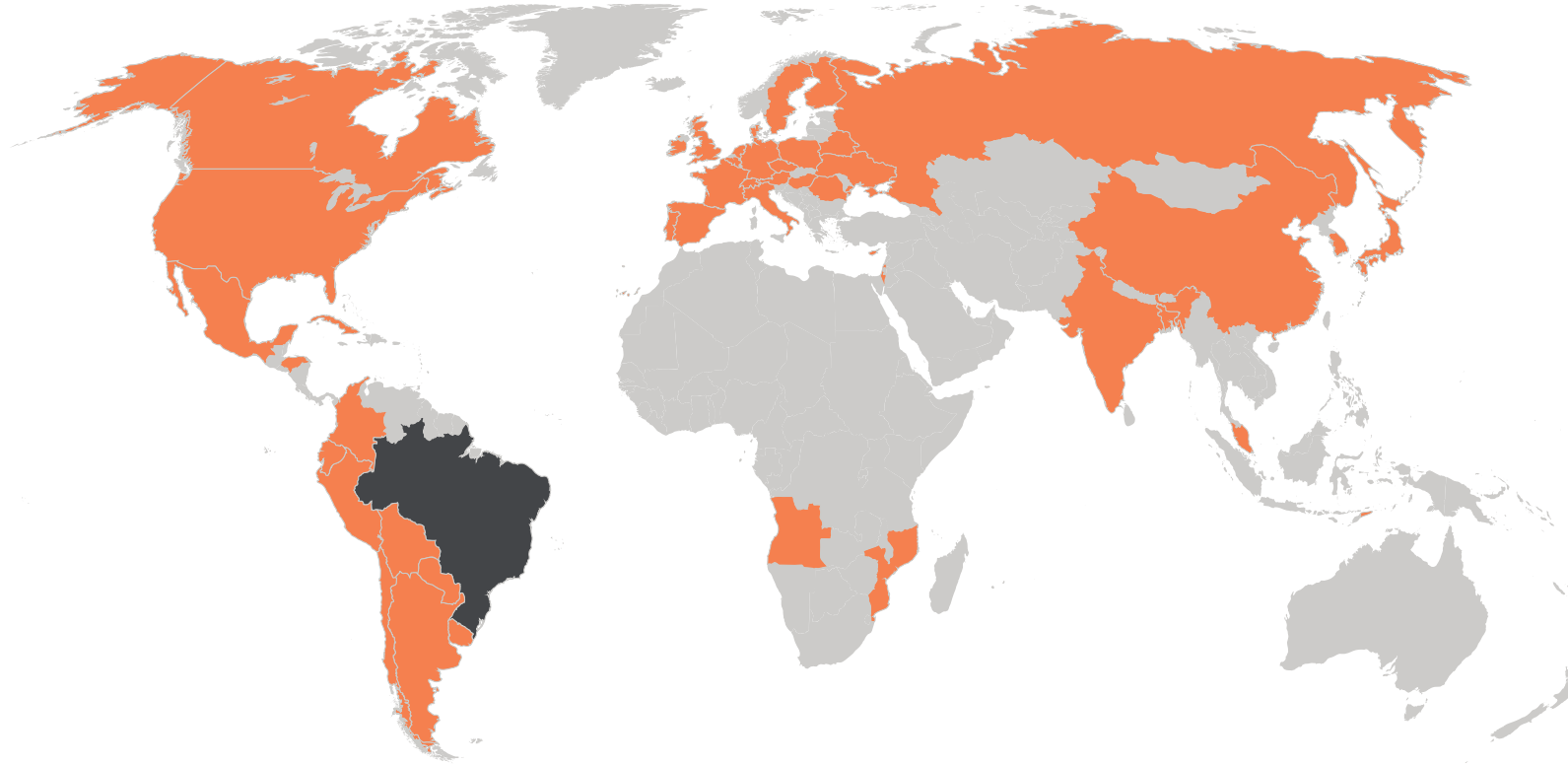




A “buddy” is an UFF student selected by the International Cooperation Office to assist incoming students, even before their arrival, with practical information regarding the city, the administrative procedures, enrollment, etc.

The Buddy Program for international students aims to promote their integration with UFF students and with the university in general. Buddies are responsible for assisting international students upon their arrival in Brazil by helping them with their adaptation to the Brazilian academic routine.
